

RECYCLE FOR RAINFORESTS

Mail Your Cell Phones:

100% of proceeds go directly to the conservation of African forests and the animals in them, including De Brazza's and colobus monkeys, gorillas, and chimpanzees.

Recycling electronics reduces demand for minerals that are illegally and destructively mined from tropical forests. Recycling also keeps hazardous electronic waste out of landfills while creating jobs here in Minnesota.

How:

1. Get Ready! Make sure you terminate your service or switch your contract to a new phone.
2. Clear personal data by manually deleting the information or removing the SIM card.
3. Seal phone (or small electronic device, working or not) in a small box, bag, or envelope. Help us save on postage by mailing cell phones only in the lightest secure packaging; accessories gladly accepted at the Zoo.
4. Cut off the attached return label and tape all edges onto the package.
5. Drop the package in the mail: postage is prepaid.

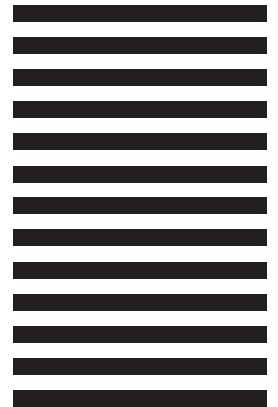
