

# SSP Animals: Who's in Charge?

The Minnesota Zoo currently participates in 24 SSP programs. The SSP species found in our collection are:

## NOTES:

1. All 24 of these animals have been cross-referenced to the attached AZA website <http://www.aza.org/ConScience/ConScienceSSPList/#P> and found to have a sponsoring institution and coordinator.
2. The following exceptions and information will help make your students searching easier.
3. The AZA website lists animals by their most common name first and then more specific. For example:
  - Red panda are found under Panda then red
  - Keel-billed toucan is listed as the Toco toucan
  - Komodo monitor is listed as the Komodo dragon
  - Przewalski's horse is listed as the Asian wild horse
  - Victoria crowned pigeon (*Goura victoria*) isn't on the AZA list, but the Pink pigeon is (scientific name *Columba mayeri*)
